## Bill Tyner

Asst. Division Engineer, Colorado Div. of Water Resources

Bill Tyner received a Bachelor of Science Degree in Civil Engineering from Colorado State University in 1982.

Bill has served as a Professional Engineer employed by the State of Colorado since 1985 and by the Colorado Division of Water Resources since 1996. He has served as Lead Engineer of the Ground Water Information Team in the Arkansas River Basin during the initial implementation of the rules that govern the use of high capacity wells and now as Assistant Division Engineer responsible for Surface Water Operations in the Arkansas River Basin which includes directing storage and release operations for several major reservoirs, administration of surface water under the priority system along the main portion of the Arkansas River, operation of the real-time stream gauging satellite network within the Arkansas River Basin in Colorado and administration of augmentation plans and substitute water supply plans.

He has also served as an expert witness in the Kansas vs. Colorado Supreme Court case where he gave testimony on behalf of the State of Colorado concerning the work he supervises to keep Colorado in compliance with the interstate compact and concerning a project he supervised to update irrigated acreage through the use of satellite imagery in the Lower Arkansas River Basin in Colorado.
